

Because I am running as an unaffiliated candidate, I need approximately 8,000 signatures to get on the ballot. Thank you for your willingness to help make that a reality!

**Before you start:**

- People signing the petition are purely helping me to be on the ballot. They are not voting for me.
- Make sure you read and align with what I stand for. People will ask you questions that you need to be able to answer.
- I need communication with you at all times. Let me know how it's going and ask me questions when they come up.
- I live in Polk county, which is in district 11. I provided an attachment of district 11 in your email.
- If people start "fighting" you, move on. They weren't meant to join. Give them a flyer.
- Make copies of the flyer, preferably in color at a printing shop and give out to those who you encounter. They can go to my website, [www.awinnfornc.com](http://www.awinnfornc.com), for more info on me.

**Instructions for the petition signature page:**

- 1) Write the county in the space provided on the petition signature page (first paragraph).
- 2) Registered voters in the county represented on each signature page have to sign the page that represents what county they are registered to vote in. They will need to print their name, provide address, zip code, their birthday and signature.
- 3) No one can sign for another person.
- 4) NC is what is called a "wet ink" state, meaning there is no electronic signing.
- 5) Once a sheet is full, make a copy, let me know and send or take the ORIGINAL to your county board of elections.
- 6) The deadline is actually 3/03/20, but I would like to have everything in by 2/27/2020.
